#### Welcome from Mrs Jackson & Miss Sampson

We are looking forward to welcoming Class 2 back to School on Monday 8th March 2021.

In the coming days and weeks our priority will be to ensure a smooth transition back into school and classroom learning. Every child's experience of remote learning will have been different. Ensuring children feel safe and secure as they return is of particular importance. We know that emotional stability is a prerequisite to learning. We will create a learning environment which supports this.

Learning will continue with a focus on children's well-being as well as their academic learning. Children will be supported to readapt to learning with others again and we will be planning opportunities for children to re-establish their friendships and social skills through games, stories and opportunities for purposeful play.

We understand that children will benefit from time to adapt to the routines of the school day including regular handwashing. They will be helped and supported to build up their learning stamina and familiarise themselves with learning as part of a class again which for some, will mean less support than they received while learning remotely.

We will have PE on a Tuesday & Thursday and we ask that similar to the Autumn term, children come to school in their school PE uniform on these days. May we also remind you that in compliance with our risk assessment the classroom doors will be open and the classrooms may be cold. Please ensure your child has adequate layers of clothing underneath their school uniform. Once routines and relationships have been re-established, we will be assessing the children to check knowledge and address any gaps. This will be achieved with a balance of regular low stakes recall quizzes and some reading and maths assessments along with a writing piece.
