Topics and Curriculum Coverage Next Year

Each term you will receive a curriculum overview with details of all the coverage for that term. More detailed overviews can be found on the school website, by clicking on either year 1 & 2 or Year 3 & 4. Next year will be 'Year A'. Phonics, reading, writing and maths will be taught daily and these usually take place during the morning. During the afternoon we will be teaching our foundation subjects which as you know are blocked together for a week or two at a time. Years 1 and 2 will continue to follow a separate curriculum to Years 3 and 4.

How you can support your child at home

The children work very hard whilst they are in school and it is important they have time to rest at home. The most helpful thing you can do to support them is to encourage a love of reading – reading to a parent, listening to a parent read, or even listening to and talking about audiobooks. Phonics sheets will also be sent out weekly, for those children on the Little Wande programme, so you can see what the children have been

learning and they can continue to practise at home.

Additionally, support with learning times tables is also very helpful. Children in Years 3 & 4 will receive a login to Times Tables Rockstars website. If you need any support with work/ideas of things to do at home then please ask and we will be happy to help.

Other class routines including PE

P.E lessons will be on a Thursday and Friday. Your child will need to wear their full PE kit on these days. During the summer term one of the PE lessons will be replaced with swimming for year 3 and 4 children.

Children in Year 3 and 4 do daily times tables quizzes to prepare for the end of year 4 times table check.
