Free School Meals-Important Update

From 1st April 2018 children entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) at any time remain entitled until they finish either primary or secondary education. This continues even if the family finances improve.

From 1st April 2025 entitlement to FSM will end <u>IF</u> income increases above £7,400 annual net income over a three-month period (for example more than £1850 net income in the last three Universal Credit assessment period). Please call the school office if you need any further information.


